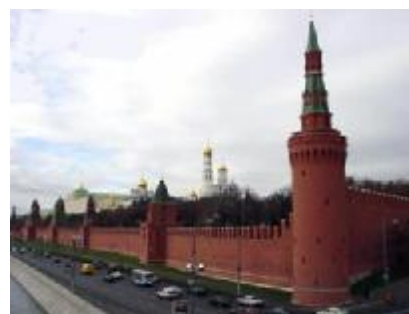

While sailing along the Moskva-river you'll see marvelous sights of Moscow. The fascinating views of the towers and walls of the Kremlin, the Cathedral of Christ the Savior, the Central House of Artists, the Gorky Park, the Andreevsky Monastery, the Moscow State University, the Hotel "Ukraina" (Radisson Royal Moscow), the Monument of Peter I, the Confectionary "Red October", the Kremlin, the Saint Basil Cathedral, the Moscow International House of Music will open in front of you and our professional guide will tell you some historical facts about these sights. All the sights look different from water.

The capital of the Russian Federation, Moscow, a unique complex of attractions, the opportunity to become acquainted with the traditions of Russian people, attracts guests from all over the world. The historical centre of Moscow, the Kremlin and its cathedrals, monasteries, fortresses and preserved boyar's palaces, demonstrates the unique culture and art of the late Middle Ages in Russia. Moscow is one of the rare cases of a city preserving its beauty in perpetuity, whatever events unfold over time. To know more about Moscow's history, our city sightseeing tour is a must.

"Russian Feast"

There is no Russian party that can do without traditional drinking vodka. Hardly anyone knows that it has a history of its own! There are even rules of drinking vodka and you can learn them participating in our folk program "Vodka-show":

- ü welcome ceremony,
- ü guided tour of Russian handicrafts museum: Gzhel, lacquer boxes, Khokhloma woodware, hand-painted porcelain, matrioshka, etc.
- ü vodka-show: traditions of Russian feast, vodka tasting, drinking toasts, Russian folk songs, conquests, a performance of our folk show group.
- ü Free-time for buying souvenirs.



The Moscow Kremlin.

The Moscow Kremlin is one of the largest architectural ensembles in the world. It is home to the Moscow Kremlin State Museum of History and Culture.

The first Kremlin walls were built in the mid-12th century. Today, part of the Kremlin is occupied by presidential offices; this area is closed to visitors. But during our tour, you will visit the majestic whitestone cathedrals of Blagoveshchensky (the Annunciation); Arkhangelsky (built in the name of Archangel Michael); and Uspensky (the Assumption), where every tsar and emperor of Russia was

crowned, the Church of the Deposition of Our Lady's Robe, the Patriarch's Chambers with the Church of the Twelve Apostles, and the Ivan the Great Bell Tower Ensemble.
